Catalyst for Educational Joins Research Partnership for Professional Learning

Educational Consulting Agency Granted Research Affiliation and Multiple Recognitions

CHICAGO (September 27, 2023) — Chicago, Ill.-based Catalyst for Educational Change (CEC), a non-profit consulting agency working with educational systems throughout the country, has joined the Research Partnership for Professional Learning (RPPL) as an affiliate.

CEC was recently recognized with the Platinum Transparency Seal by Candid. Candid (formerly GuideStar) serves as the world's largest source of information on non-profit organizations. This puts CEC in the top 0.1% of nonprofits nationally in terms of financial health, accountability, and transparency.

In addition, CEC received a Four-Star rating from Charity Navigator. This rating designates CEC as an official "Give with Confidence" charity, indicating that the agency is using its donations effectively based on Charity Navigator's criteria. Charity Navigator is America's largest and most-utilized independent charity evaluator. Since 2001, the



organization has been an unbiased and trusted source of information for more than 11 million donors annually.
