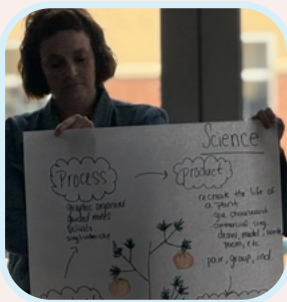


High-Quality Instructional Practices

Phase 1: Building Awareness

Stakeholders: Leadership & All Staff

Prepares the school community for change by assessing current practices, building understanding of evidence-based instruction, and creating a shared vision.

Phase 2: Integration & Alignment

Stakeholders: All Staff

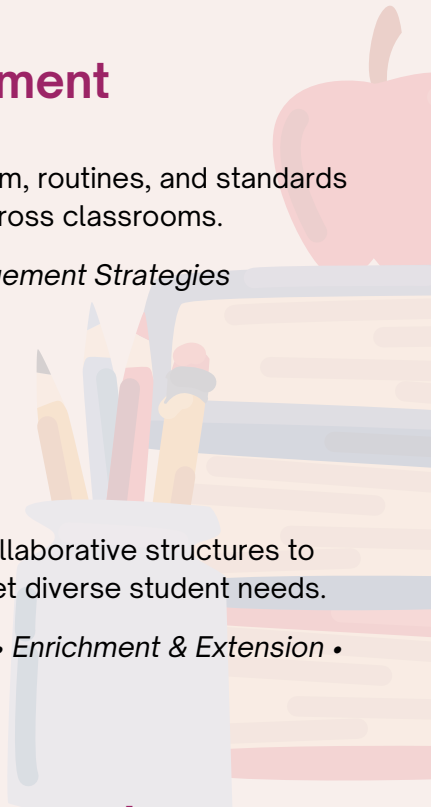


Phase 4: Monitoring & Refinement
